Student Day is a non-competitive evaluation of students' personal progress. It encourages students of all levels and talents to develop their music skills to the fullest extent. Students are evaluated on Written Theory, Aural Theory, and Performance. Aural Theory tests are given in groups at each level, with assigned times. Written Theory tests are given on a walk-in basis anytime between 11:00AM and 5:30PM.

Please read the following very carefully:

1 – **ALL Theory tests, Performance & Keyboard Skills** – Levels Primary – 12, will be held on one day: **Saturday, March 7, at Palm Beach Atlantic University, 326 Acacia Road, West Palm Beach.** (See driving directions on next page.)

2 – **Registration fees: \$25 For each student in levels Primary-12**

If a student cannot possibly attend on the scheduled date, their teacher should arrange a make-up with a qualified judge prior to that date, if possible. An additional charge of \$15 will be payable to the make-up teacher.

Driving directions from I-95:

Take the Okeechobee Blvd. exit (70) and head east 1.5 miles. (Immediately after crossing the railroad tracks you will see City Place on your left). Stay in the RIGHT LANE and cross a second set of railroad tracks. IMMEDIATELY after the Jaguar dealership on the right, turn right onto S. Dixie.

Take second left onto Acacia Road, then immediate left into the visitor parking lot. Walk across the street to the Vera Lea Rinker Hall. Enter the east door, not the front door, and take the elevator to the third floor.

STUDENTS MAY WALK IN AND TAKE THEIR WRITTEN TESTS ANY TIME before or after their Aural test, as long as they can be finished by 6:00.

Level 1 will be administered at 11:00 am and again at 4:30 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 2 will be administered at 11:15 am and again at 4:45 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 3 will be administered at 11:35 am and again at 5:10 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 4 will be administered at 12:00 pm and again at 5:30 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 5 will be administered at 12:30 pm only

Level 6 will be administered at 1:00 pm only

Level 7 will be administered at 1:30 pm only

Level 8 will be administered at 2:00 pm only

Level 9 at 2:30 pm only

Level 10 at 3:00 pm only

Level 11 at 3:30 pm only

Level 12 at 4:00 pm only
