

STUDENT DAY TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

ALL Theory Testing, Performance and Keyboard Skills will be done on the same day, Saturday, March 7, 2020, 11:00AM – 6:00 PM at Palm Beach Atlantic University, Vera Lea Rinker Hall – 325 Acacia Road, WPB.

AWARDS: Level 7 students will receive a small trophy...Level 10, a larger trophy...Level 11 an acrylic trophy, Level 12 a crystal trophy from PBCMTA and a wooden plaque from FSMTA. Students in Levels 7 – 12 who choose to do Theory Only or Performance Only will receive the FSMTA Honors Medal only if they receive Honors (90% - 100%).

Registration Fee for each student **Levels Primary – 12 is \$25.**

NO REFUNDS will be given. If a student cannot possibly come on March 7, please arrange a make-up with a qualified judge prior to March 7. EMERGENCY only absences will be allowed to be made up after March 7. The parents must pay an additional fee of \$15 directly to the make-up teacher.

Special Notes:

All students must memorize and perform original compositions by different composers. No “arrangements”, please!

Levels 5 – 12 must perform compositions representing three different historical periods of music.

Internet copies which display proper copyright and credits are permissible, but must be accompanied by the attached Verification Form, page 3 (also available at fnta.org).

Students may perform compositions one level higher or one level lower than their theory level; however, please be sensitive to the true level of your student's abilities in order to make this a very positive and enjoyable experience. There is a “Suggested Repertoire List” for all levels, available at fnta.org

Keep audition time, which includes pieces plus keyboard skills, within the following allotment for each level:

Primary and Level 1 = 10 minutes

Levels 2 & 3 = 15 minutes

Levels 4 & 5 = 18 minutes

Levels 6 & 7 = 20 minutes

Levels 8 & 9 = 25 minutes

Levels 10-12 = 30 minutes

Driving directions from I-95:

Take the Okeechobee Blvd. exit (70) and head east 1.5 miles. (Immediately after crossing the railroad tracks you will see City Place on your left). Stay in the RIGHT LANE and cross a second set of railroad tracks. IMMEDIATELY after the Jaguar dealership on the right, turn right onto S. Dixie. Take second left onto Acacia Road, then immediate left into the visitor parking lot. Walk across the street to the Vera Lea Rinker Hall. Enter the east door, not the front door, and take the elevator to the third floor.

STUDENTS MAY WALK IN AND TAKE THEIR WRITTEN TESTS ANY TIME before or after their Aural test, as long as they complete it by 5:30.

AURAL TESTING IS GIVEN IN GROUPS, AT THESE TIMES:

Level 1 will be administered at 11:00 am and again at 4:30 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 2 will be administered at 11:15 am and again at 4:45 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 3 will be administered at 11:35 am and again at 5:10 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 4 will be administered at 12:00 pm and again at 5:30 pm (Student chooses AM or PM)

Level 5 will be administered at 12:30 pm only

Level 6 will be administered at 1:00 pm only

Level 7 will be administered at 1:30 pm only

Level 8 will be administered at 2:00 pm only

Level 9 at 2:30 pm only

Level 10 at 3:00 pm only

Level 11 at 3:30 pm only

Level 12 at 4:00 pm only
